### ADMISSION GUIDE

1. The Erasmus Office of the Tor Vergata School of Sciences receives the list of students selected by the partner university via the Mobint platform.
2. Once appointed, the students receive from Tor Vergata instructions to preregister online at: [mobint.uniroma2.it](http://mobint.uniroma2.it).
3. Students must enrol in our university before the deadline.
4. Tor Vergata International mobility Office sends invitation letters to students for visa application; in case of students from a European Union country, this process is not present.
5. Before arriving at Tor Vergata, incoming students must enter on the Mobint profile the Learning Agreement to be accepted by the teacher of the Course.
6. Once the Learning Agreement has been accepted, the registration is completed. Upon arrival at the Erasmus office of the School of Sciences, students must bring with them the "Certificate of Arrival" which will be signed by their contact person.
7. Incoming students have the right to modify their Learning Agreement if there are time constraints and/or inconsistencies.
8. At the end of the mobility, students will have to sign the "Mobility Term Form" and will then receive their Transcript of Records.
